Doctors and availability

We would like to remind patients that reception staff are only able to offer appointments for specific doctors where there is availability.

If there is no availability with your chosen doctor, you will be offered the next available appointment with another doctor.

Please remember, the reception staff are here to help you however, they you provide with cannot an appointment if there is not one available. Our reception staff follow a protocol agreed with the doctors, so please do not shout or get angry with them. If you have a problem with any services provided by the practice, please ask to speak to someone: please do not take it out on our reception staff they are only trying to help you.

On-line Services:

If you previously used our on-line services, please speak to reception if you have not completed an application to register for our new on-line services.

We will need proof of your identification e.g. passport, driving licence, or another acceptable form of ID and proof of your current registered address. ACCESS A SUMMARY OF YOUR MEDICAL RECORDS ON-LINE

Patients can now access their medical records on-line via their On-line Services account.

If you do not already have an Online Service account set up, or would like to add medical records to your current on-line account please speak to reception who will arrange an appointment for you to set an account up, or amend your current registration.

PLEASE NOTE, you will need to bring a current in date passport or photo driving licence, with the paper counterpart, to the appointment, so your ID can be verified.

On-line Access registration forms can be obtained from reception, or downloaded from the surgery website at:

NHS111

If you need medical help fast but it's not a lifethreatening situation, you can call NHS 111. When you call 111, a trained adviser will ask you questions to find out what's wrong, give you medical advice and direct you to someone who can help you, like an out-of-hour doctor or a community nurse or send an ambulance.

If you don't speak English, tell the adviser what language you want to speak and they will get you an interpreter.

You can call 111 any time of the day. The call is free, from landlines and mobiles.

When should I use it?

You should only call 999 in an emergency – for example, when someone's life is at risk or someone is seriously injured or critically ill.

For health needs that are not urgent, you should call your GP surgery during normal opening hours.

Call **111** if we are closed and you need medical help fast, but it's not life-threatening.
